Minutes from the General Meeting:

The candidacy of Máximo Caturla was approved unanimously and acclaimed.

In his welcoming words, Mr. Caturla stated the goals for the following years: integrate more associations in the Federation as well as recover some that have been unlinked; maintain collaboration and support the projects of Entreculturas/Alboan. Above all, make ours, the project of Barcelona 21, to which the Federation gives full support so that it will be a success of attendees, contents...

- Project proposed by Entreculturas Alboan, with United in the Mission. This year we will direct our aid and support to a Venezuelan project: Faith and Joy.
- World Congress 2021: Program and Shared Activities and Experiences. The sessions will begin on July 14th, with an Opening Eucharist at Sta. María del Mar Basilic to be presided by Father General and the Archbishop of Barcelona and will end on the 18th of the same month. There will be a previous Pilgrimage from Loyola-Verdú-Montserrat-La Cova. The V Centennial of the Conversion of Saint Ignatius and this pilgrimage will be included in their celebrations. It will be a meeting of young people where they will talk about Reconciliation between people, with the Creation and with God.
- The celebration in Valencia of the XII Congress of the Spanish Federation of ancient students, at the Colegio de San José.
